

**PIA FRIES** (b. 1955 in Beromünster, Switzerland) studied at the Lucerne University of Applied Science and Arts, Lucerne, Switzerland, and at the Academy of the Arts, Düsseldorf, Germany, where she studied under Gerhard Richter. From 2014 to 2023, Fries held a professorship at the Academy of Fine Arts, Munich, Germany.

Over the course of her nearly-four decade career, Fries has exhibited internationally at numerous institutions and galleries. In 1999, her work was included in the 48th Venice Biennale, *dAPERTutto*, curated by Harald Szeemann. Notable solo exhibitions of her work have been held at Kunsthau Baselland, Münchenstein, Switzerland; Museum Kunstpalast, Düsseldorf, Germany; Musée d'Art Moderne de Paris, Paris, France; Staatliche Kunsthalle Karlsruhe, Karlsruhe, Germany; Josef Albers Museum Quadrat Bottrop, Bottrop, Germany; Kunstmuseum Luzern, Lucerne, Switzerland, and elsewhere.
